The Global Survey of Public Servants (GSPS) is an initiative to generate survey data from public servants in government institutions around the world. The aim of the initiative is to increase the volume, quality and coherence of survey data on public administration.

Understanding the motivations, behaviors, organizational environments and management practices of public servants through surveys is central to (1) better understand how public services and states around the world work; and, (2) help governments manage public services better.
